The Commission on Waterways and Public Lands, acting under the provisions of Chapter 523 of the Acts of 1913, hereby approves permits issued May 1, 1917, by the Selectmen of the town of Provincetown to the Long Point Weir Co., J. H. Dyer, Agent, to set and maintain fish traps in the tide waters of Provincetown.

The location of said traps is indicated by Nos. G and I on chart of Provincetown Harbor on file in this office and on file in the office of the Selectmen of Provincetown.

Nothing herein contained shall be construed as approving the location of any fish trap in Provincetown Harbor beyond the harbor line established by Chapter 268 of the Acts of 1867, and Chapter 59 of the Acts of 1877.

The approval of these permits may be modified or revoked by this Commission at any time, after notice and hearing, without claim for compensation therefor, but in any event shall expire May 1, 1918.
