Attention of Mr Snow,-

Dear Mr Snow: I am returning herewith the Massachusetts Tax Return and have made the changes you request. Your real estate and machinery are not assessed together as real estate, but the last separate assessment of the machinery was \$20,000. If therefore you will deduct from your last total assessment made by the Provincetown assessors \$20,000, the remainder will be the real estate figure which should be inserted in Table A, Column 2. In Table IV under Fair Cash Value I have inserted "Machinery \$20,000" and the Fair Cash Value of the Liberty Bonds given by you is right, even though it is less than the figure at which they are carried on your books.

This return should be filed on or before April 10th, but if you send it away in Monday's mail I believe it will be acceptable to the Tax Commissioner.
