

A NATIONAL TREASURE SAILS AGAIN!

The whaleship Charles W. Morgan was launched in New Bedford in 1841. After an 80-year career and 37 voyages that spanned the globe, she is now on exhibit at Mystic Seaport where she tells the story of whaling's role in U.S. history. A National Historic Landmark, the Morgan is the oldest American commercial vessel still afloat and the last remaining wooden whaleship in the world.

In summer 2014, she will embark on an extraordinary 38th Voyage to historic ports in New England, including New London, Newport, Vineyard Haven, New Bedford, Provincetown, and Boston.
