



The "Town Home"
Provincetown, Mass.




The Town Infirmary, on Alden Street, with Monument Hill on the left. ----- 1915
Built 1870 at a cost of \$6,526, "affording a comfortable and commodious home for the unfortunate dependents upon the town's charity."




Arrow on right: Entrance to New Cemetery where Grandma and Grandpa Perkins, and Mother (Annie Boxell) are buried (See below)
