E. I. Nye (Wellfleet) has lately come in possession of a valuable relic in the form of an ancient English Bible, with annotations and parallel passages by Samuel Clark. Printed in London in 1690, it has a further interest from the fact that it was taken from the British Frigate, Somerset, wrecked at Provincetown in 1778. The bible was purchased by Mr. Nye of Mr. Jesse Cobb of Truro, whose great uncle, Mr. Richard Cobb, took it from the wreck. It is a large folio volume 17X10, bound in vellum and in fair condition.—From the Patriot of March 25, 1895.

This Bible is now the property of the Research Club and housed in the Historical Museum, Provincetown.
