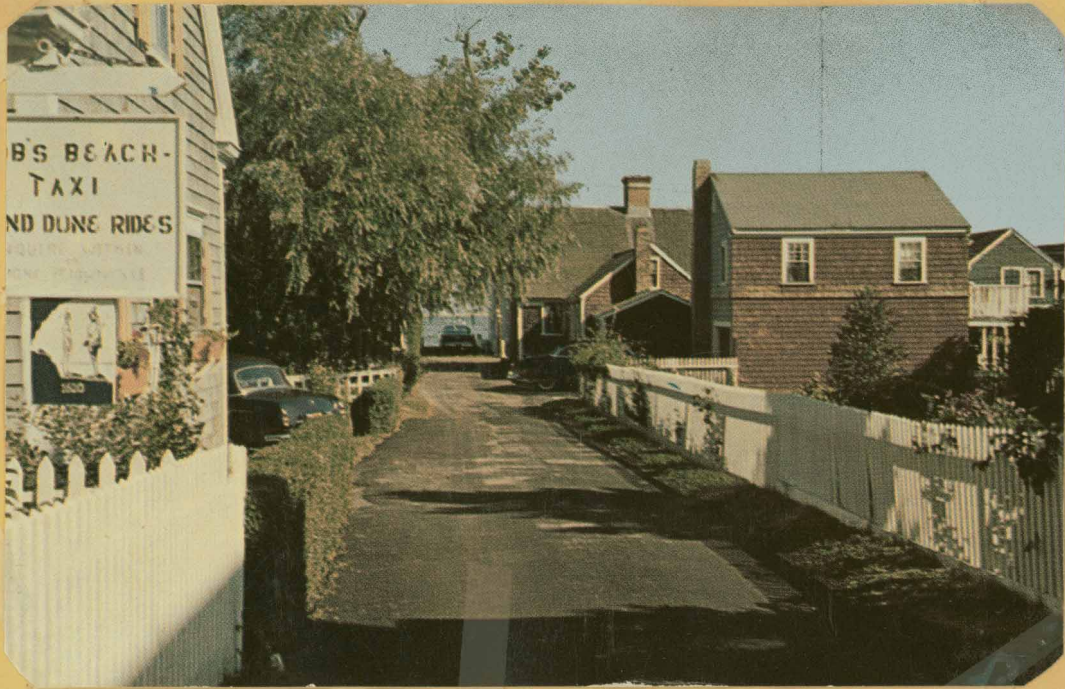

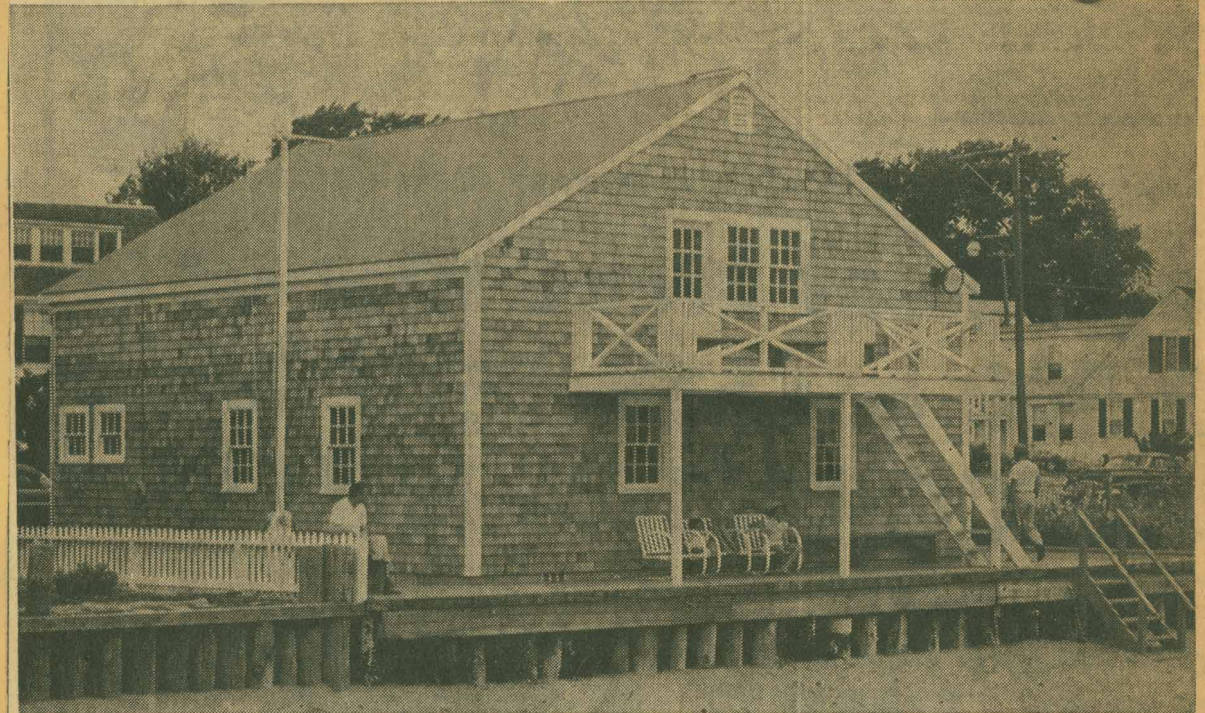
Looking down Soper Street to Commercial - 1965
