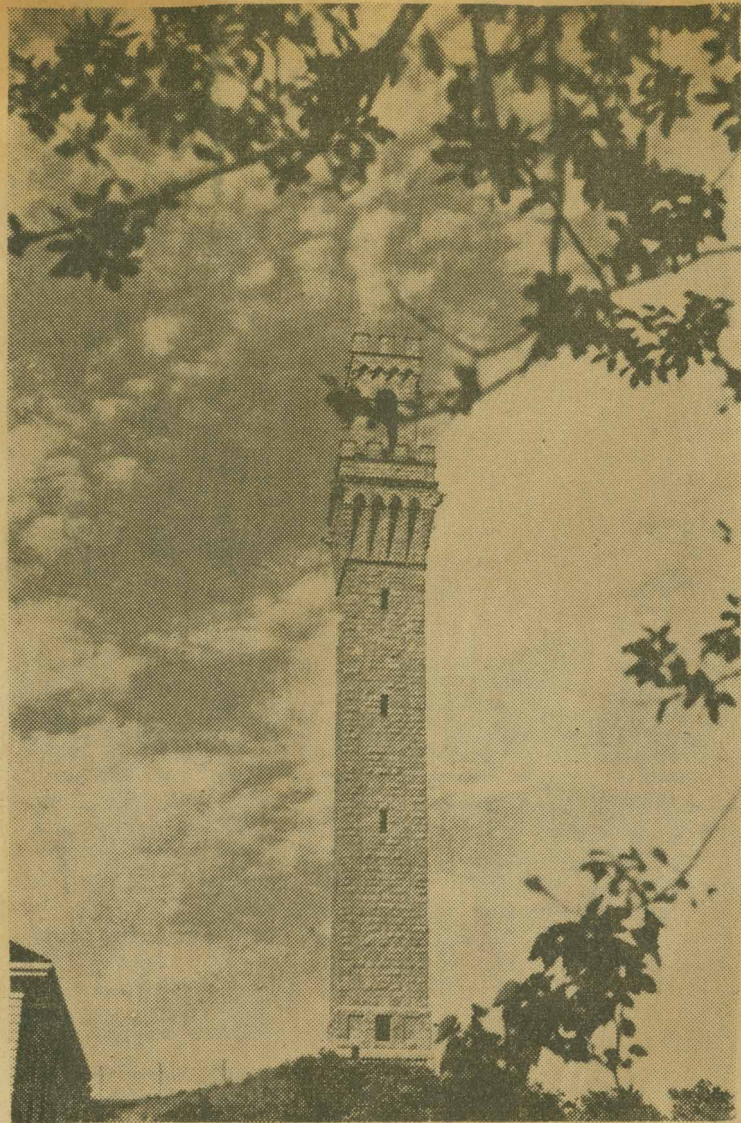


Passes 30th Birthday 1940
