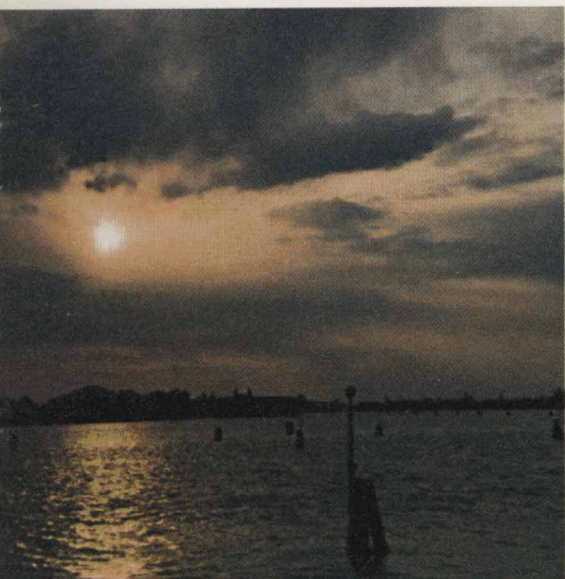
Mr. Fred Turner

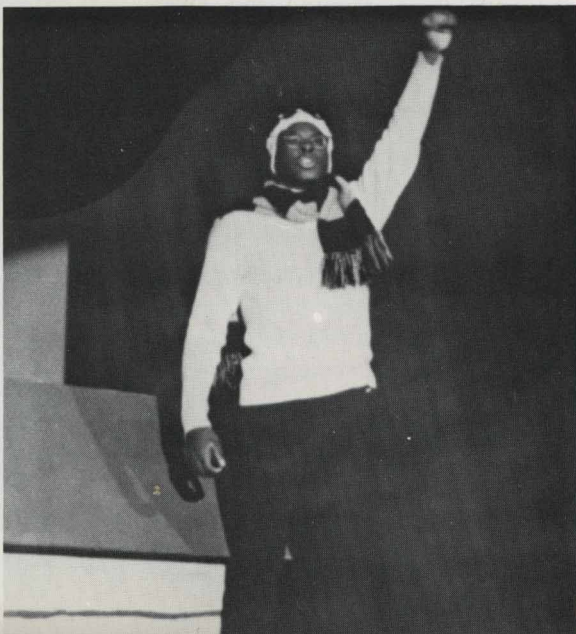
Senior Class History

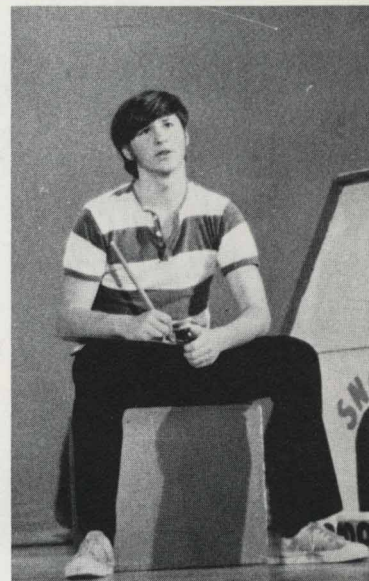

The first event of our junior year was the operation of the concession stand. Our efforts proved to be quite profitable and rewarding as we participated in our first business experience of the year.

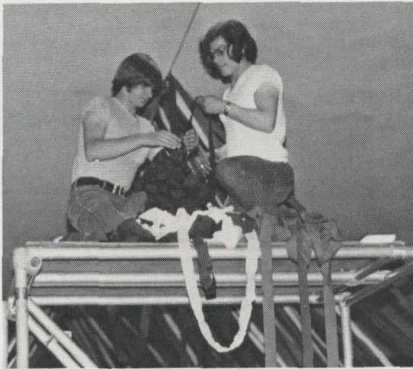
Before long, our plans and goals were set to make

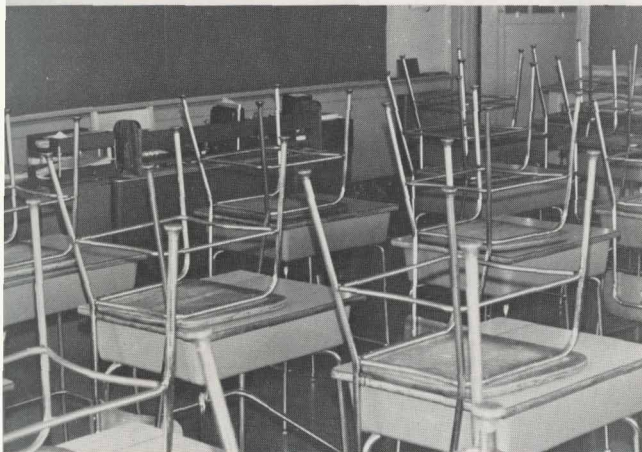
we had looked up to the upperclassmen, now, we were the upperclassmen. Everyone promised he or she would make this year a memorable one.
